Programme Overview

The Board of Quantity Surveying Malaysia (BQSM) has enforced the revised Quantity Surveyors Act on 1st January 2017. The revised act provides two-tier registration namely Professional Quantity Surveyor (PQS) and Consultant Quantity Surveyor (CQS). The first tier registration to become a PQS can be attained via the Graduate Route, the Experience Route and the Academic Route. Prior to that, a candidate who is currently registered as Provisional QS must undergo the Assessment of Professional Competence (APC) conducted by BQSM.

Why APC? The APC is the qualifying assessment for registration as Professional Quantity Surveyors. The APC emphasizes technical competencies of a professional quantity surveyor through structured training for the minimum levels of requirements in knowledge, skills and abilities. The candidates are expected to demonstrate skills and abilities at level 1 to 3 in the Final Assessment. The APC will establish that a candidate has:

- learned to apply his theoretical knowledge through professional training and experience for practical quantity surveying skills;
- has achieved a satisfactory level of understanding and application of the skills that form an essential part of the knowledge base of his chosen specialists' practice;
- is aware of the need to pay particular attention to accuracy and essential detail to safeguard the interests of employers and clients;
- is aware of and acts in accordance with the Board's Rules of Conduct to possess the highest level of professional integrity and objectivity, and
- recognizes his ethical duties to clients, employers and the community.

Learning Outcomes

- Prepare the APC's technical competency workbook and analysis;
- Apply his theoretical knowledge through professional training and experience for practical quantity surveying skills; and
- Understand the importance of ethics and integrity in QS profession and how to act in an ethical manner.
